

Mount Rogers Bike Skills Track Committee: Update Week 8

8 students have been chosen to represent the school's student body to help voice their opinions about what elements they would like in their bike skills track at Mount Rogers Primary School. We have 2 students from each grade between 3-6, so as to get an overall opinion from a range of grades.

So far the students have visited Majura Pines and Stromlo Forest Park where they had the opportunity to ride trails and experience what is possible in a bike track. The group then went on to visit schools which have already created bike skills tracks. These included North Ainslie Primary School and Melrose High School. Both schools were very generous with their time telling us about their journey and allowing time for questions.

The students have come away with a good understanding of what is possible in a bike skills track and are now eagerly planning the bike track they would like at Mount Rogers. There have been some very exciting suggestions, as well as a demonstrated understanding for what the younger children may want and could achieveably ride. The group is very keen to make a track which is accessible to all students of various ages and riding ability.
